

Stay safe: vehicle site access

By safely disposing of your liquid waste, you are helping to protect the natural environment. But it's important to protect yourself and others too.

Every year there are over 5000 accidents¹ involving transport in the workplace. The main causes of injury are people falling off vehicles, or being struck or crushed by them.

As each of our sites is unique, it's vital that you adhere to site traffic management rules so that everyone can go home safely.

When arriving to our sites please:

- Follow the designated traffic route
- Observe the site speed limit
- Beware of pedestrians, site plant and other vehicles
- Observe any height restrictions
- Park in clearly marked bays with brakes applied
- Reverse park if driving a car and van

Never leave a vehicle unattended without ensuring the vehicle and trailer are securely braked, the engine is turned off and the key removed.

If you need to reverse be extra vigilant of your surroundings paying particular attention to pedestrians, lighting, signs, barriers, banks, verges, equipment and other vehicles.

Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment:



Before entering our sites for the first time all drivers must complete a safety induction and be aware of the dangers.

Vehicles must also be well maintained and drivers must be trained and competent to operate the vehicle safely.
